LEGAL NOTICE OF RULEMAKING
Request for Public Comment
In compliance with Act 434 of 1967, the Administrative Procedures Act, as amended, notice is hereby given that the Arkansas Tobacco Control Division of the Department of Finance and Administration intends to adopt Amended Rule titled, "Rules of Arkansas Tobacco Control Board." The purpose of the Amended Rule is to update rule language regarding rebating to be in harmony with the language of Act 942 of 2021; to add rule language regarding the 30-day grace period provided under Act 386 of 2021; to add rule language regarding online sales of cigars and related safe measures to prevent online sales and shipping to minors in light of Act 940 of 2021 and A.C.A. § 5-227 (Sales to Minors); to update ATC permit fees to mirror the permit fees contained in A.C.A. § 26-57-219 (Act 1071 of 2019); and to update and modify language and formatting for overall grammar, clarity, and harmonization with applicable ATC statutes.
A public comment hearing will be held on April 14, 2022, at 10:00 AM in the first-floor conference room at 101 E. Capitol Ave., Suite 119, Little Rock, Arkansas 72201.
